INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

1. Our Website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Website and also allows us to improve our Website.
2. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your device if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your device's hard drive.
3. Cookies can be stored for varying lengths of time on your browser or device. Session cookies are deleted from your device when you close your web browser. Persistent cookies will remain stored on your device until deleted or until they reach their expiry date.
4. We use the following cookies:
 - Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our Website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our Website, protect visitors from spam or fraud, or make use of e-billing services. Because these cookies are strictly necessary, we do not need to ask for your consent to use them.
 - Analytical or performance cookies.** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. We may need to seek your consent to use them.
 - Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our Website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, localise your experience, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, by providing you with your previous Drop history).

_ga	This is a cookie used by Google Analytics to distinguish users	2 years
_gid	This is a cookie used by Google Analytics used to distinguish users	24 hours
_gat	This is a cookie used by Google Analytics to throttle request rate	1 minute
